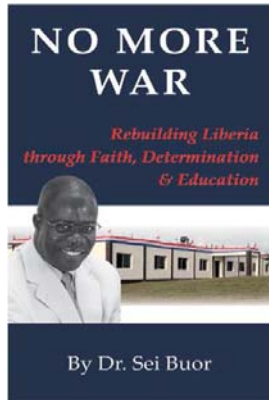


Liberia International Christian College Welcomes First Students

As the reader walks the ten miles to school with young Sei, he learns how important education becomes to a young man with aspirations.

Over the years, education became the driving force of Sei Buor’s life. After his life-changing conversion to Christianity, his purpose for obtaining education was to rebuild and stabilize Liberia.
