Dear Friends in Christ,

We are grateful for your partnership with us year-after-year in supporting our commitment and mutual effort to create opportunities for Liberians to serve Christ across nations!

Thank you for your dedicated prayer and contributions this year. The good news is that the Lord has met all, not a few, but all of our operation and ministry needs.

I am asking you to please consider making a generous year-end contribution to cover our ministry support for this **coming year**. With increased ministry opportunities in Liberia, our budget for 2011 is **\$164,000** which includes our moderate personal support per month.



Your generous support towards our 2010 matching grant allowed us to complete the LICC 2nd floor in October 2010 with **7 classrooms and 4 offices**. More than 40 new students will be enrolled in various programs when the new semester begins in January 2011 bringing the

total number of LICC students to 137. Our current overall classroom capacity has doubled and we will continue to welcome all qualified students to our campus, as well as 200 additional adult learners in continuing education and leadership training seminars.

ULICAF Leadership Summit - Noblesville, Indiana held November 12-14, 2010

The year of 2010 has been both exciting and challenging. This is why our leaders came together for this year's summit to pray and fellowship together. During the weekend we launched **STEP INTO OUR STORY**, a 3-year stewardship campaign to raise funds to launch the construction of the LICC **library and administrative offices building**.

More than 75 friends, families and board members gathered at Grace Community Church on Saturday, November 13 for a luncheon and learned our faithful God has something for all of us to do together. Several of our friends called it the ***Moment*** for ULICAF. This is because we all had the opportunity to offer a special send-off prayer for our mission team going to Liberia, and prayer of healing on behalf of dear friends who are going through life's battles.

Our short term mission team includes ***Pastor Dave Rodriguez***, Senior Pastor of Grace Community Church; ***Keith Carlson***, Pastor of Outreach and Leadership Development at Grace Community Church; ***Ruth Schwartz***, ULICAF Treasurer; ***Russ Schwartz***,

ULICAF Strategic Consultant; Sei Buor, ULICAF Executive Director; and Dr. Shadrach Gonqueh, ULICAF Board President. The team is planning to depart for Liberia on January 15, 2011.

We have a vision with plans to continue to minister to thousands of Liberian immigrants that are resettled in the United States, those in the nation of Liberia under the auspices of Grace Frontline Ministries, ULICAF and now also through the Liberia International Christian College. Unfortunately we cannot carry out those plans if our personal and ministry needs are not met.

There are 4 important needs:

1. **Student scholarship fund:** 95% of current 97 students and 40 incoming students in January will need some kind of financial assistance. Many students would not be able to attend without assistance provided by your gifts. **\$1,200** (\$100 per month) gift will support a nursing student, and **\$1,000** (\$85 per month) will support a LICC student for one whole year!
2. **Faculty salary support:** We need to attract and retain top teaching faculty and administrators. Your gift of **\$4,200 per year**, (\$400 per month) will cover a professor's salary for one whole year.
3. **Visiting Faculty Housing:** **\$12,000** will complete the Visiting Faculty House currently under construction on the campus of LICC. Gifts are needed for plastering, plumbing, electricity and installing water.
4. **Operational budget:** ULICAF depends heavily on the generous giving of families and friends for our operational budget of **\$5,500** per month to meet our modest payroll, office expenses, printing & communication and office space needs.



Friends, although we have had challenges and great moments, we stand now and face the future with the confidence that the Liberia International Christian College is going to press forward to change the face of Liberia by training Christian leaders who believe in God, virtue and Liberian liberty and can confront all forms of injustices in the nation of Liberia.

Again, would you please consider making a generous year-end contribution so that we can proceed with assurance, so ULICAF's vision and impact can continue to make a difference for the Kingdom?
