## LICC OPERATIONS UPDATE

LICC is working to reach a new level of transparency and high standard within its operations. With new policies, and in some positions new people in place, the college is working quickly to be compliant with many Liberia Labor Law.

One such compliance is the issuance of employment contracts and pay. After being in operation for over ten years the college is taking steps to be a model of operating at high standards, even when it means

financially bearing a heavy burden, such as severance pay.

The financial means to cover this obligation was daunting as it is a large expense unplanned and not budgeted, but prayers are being answered and the process will be complete soon. LICC will continue to exist as a Christ centered institution in Liberia.

## *Clean Drinking Water On LICC Campus*


Hope 2 Liberia returned to LICC with a team of water engineers to finish installing a water filtration system that is the second such system on the entire continent of Africa.
