LICC Nursing Building Dedication

I also want to take this opportunity to provide updates on our ministry activities. On March 4, 2025, I traveled to Liberia along with five ULICAF Board members for the dedication of the Nursing Building at LICC, which was named in honor of our late Executive Director, Rev. Karney Dunah. The building is now officially known as “The Dunah Nursing Building.” In recognition of his dedication to ULICAF, Liberia International Christian College (LICC), and the Liberian people, we hope to keep his memory alive through this tribute.

I would especially like to thank Mr. Sean McNichols and his family for their instrumental role in designing and creating a plaque, which is now displayed next to the front door of the Nursing Building, bearing the image of Rev. Karney Dunah.

The dedication ceremony was attended by over 100 people, including high-ranking government officials, community leaders, and clergy members from local churches.

Another exciting development is our new partnership with **United Liberia Inland Church (ULIC)** and **Hope Africa University (HAU)**. Through this collaboration, **LICC has sent two nurses**—both of whom already hold Bachelor of Science degrees in nursing—to pursue their master's degrees at HAU, with the plan for them to return in two years as faculty members in LICC's Nursing Department.

Hope Africa University, located in Burundi (just south of Rwanda), is known for producing highly competent nursing graduates. In fact, their alumni are described as being “everywhere - unafraid to work in rural environments!” We are thrilled to partner with such a reputable institution, and with these two students as the first cohort, we are hopeful this marks the beginning of bringing the same level of excellence in nurse training to LICC.
